



# BLADE SPRAY™



Apply BladeSpray liberally to both sides of your freshly taped stick. BladeSpray penetrates the tape and dries clear in about 10 minutes. Your stick keeps that freshly taped feel through several games. You will save money on tape because your tape will last at least 5 times longer than normal. You can tune your stick with BladeSpray. Once your first application has dried, hold the can a little further away and fog the blade. The BladeSpray will dry with a gritty feel, which can improve puck handling and shooting accuracy. BladeSpray can be re-applied between games. A can of BladeSpray will provide at least 15 applications. A can of BladeSpray will last the entire season for most players.



BladeSpray can be used on the grip of your stick. The white grip on the left has broken down because of sweat. BladeSpray protects and waterproofs your stick's grip. The black grip on the left has had an application of BladeSpray.



BladeSpray works great on floor hockey and ball hockey sticks. BladeSpray will toughen and protect the tape. BladeSpray can be used to prevent taped floor hockey sticks from leaving marks on the floor. If you are not allowed to have tape on the bottom of your stick, follow these instructions: Tape your stick normally. With an exacto knife, score along the tape near the bottom of the blade. Remove the tape from the bottom of the blade. Apply BladeSpray to seal the taped edges, especially where you cut. Your tape will stay in place with no tape on the bottom of the blade.
